

Instructions to follow after an act of microblading or permanent makeup

- No water, cleansers, creams, makeup or any other product on the treated area for 5 days



Itching and flaking will appear in the first 7 days of post microblading, however, experience has shown that following these subsequent care instructions these symptoms may go away quickly.

- Allow 14 to 30 days for wounds to heal completely; touch-ups cannot be done between 30 and 60 days after the initial procedure.
 - **What to expect after the procedure?**
- Your new eyebrows will go through several phases during the healing cycles. The skin pigment will appear very strong and dark immediately after the procedure, because the pigment is still sitting on top of the skin and has not penetrated completely. The color of the pigment gradually softens. Do not worry if you see some pigment on the cotton swab. It's either the excess pigment or a body fluid that naturally comes out of your skin. Once the skin begins to heal, it will look like dandruff or dry skin. The impression that the pigment in the color fades faster.
